The Community Arts Network of Oneonta (CANO) is excited to announce our 13th Annual Members' Exhibition. Every current CANO member is invited to submit at least one work for exhibition in the Wilber Mansion galleries. We relish this opportunity to showcase the work of our members and highlight our regional creativity.

Important Dates

February 10 - February 23 : Interested CANO Members are invited to **register** for the exhibit online at canoneonta.org. Member artists unable to register online are encouraged to email Jenny Rosenzweig, Development & Program Director, at jenny@canoneonta.org.

Wednesday, March 4, 5-7p and Thursday, March 5, 10a-3p: Participating artists can **drop off** their ready-to-install works at the Wilber Mansion, 11 Ford Avenue, Oneonta. Please use the parking-lot entrance. Online pre-registration is not required. If not pre-registering online, please print, complete and bring a registration form to drop-off or be prepared to complete a registration form on-site at drop-off.

Friday, March 13, 5-7p: Artists and the community are invited to the CANO Members' Exhibit Opening Reception. Light refreshments will be available.

Friday, April 3, 2-4p and Wednesday, April 8, 10a-3p: Artists can pick-up any unsold work from the Wilber Mansion, 11 Ford Avenue, Oneonta. Please use the parking-lot entrance and bring any necessary packing material.

Additional Details

Entry requirements: This exhibition is open to all current members of CANO, ages 18 or older. Each member can submit up to 3 works for consideration. If any submission is in excess of 36" x 36" (including a frame), please contact Jenny Rosenzweig, Development & Program Director, at jenny@canoneonta.org in advance of drop-off. Submissions should be recently created work - completed within the last 5 years - and have *not* been previously exhibited at CANO. Due to space limitations, members are guaranteed that at least one piece will be accepted based on size on a first come, first served basis.

All mediums are welcome, including but not limited to painting, drawing, photography, textiles, ceramic, and video.

Membership: CANO Membership is required. You may become a new member or renew your membership at the time of registration at www.canoneonta.org/become-a-member.

Submission Fee: A benefit of membership, there is no submission fee for the annual CANO Members' Exhibition.

Artwork: Work must be ready-to-install with hardware and hanging wire. Sculpture must be freestanding or ready-to install. Wall-mounted works should not exceed 40 lbs. Works of video and/or sound should be submitted with all necessary engagement equipment.

Delivery: Artwork must be delivered in person to the Wilber Mansion, 11 Ford Avenue, Oneonta NY during the designated drop-off times indicated above. *Work must be labeled* with your name, title, media, and sale price (or NFS).

Pick-up: Artists can pick-up their unsold work on Friday, April 3, 2-4p and Wednesday, April 8, 10a-3p. Any work not retrieved within 14 days will be considered abandoned. Please contact Jenny Rosenzweig, Development & Program Director, at jenny@canoneonta.org to arrange for pick-up outside of the designated dates and times.

Sales & Commission: Work is not required to be for sale. Sales will be made payable to CANO and applicable sales tax will be added. At the end of the exhibition, CANO will issue payment to an artist in the amount of 75% of the listed price and retain 25% for commission for each work sold & paid for in full. In the event any artwork sells within 30 days of the end of the exhibition, but due to the buyer having seen it at the CANO gallery, the 25% commission will still be in effect. In this case, the Artist is responsible to pay CANO the commission fee by May 15, 2026. Any shipping and handling costs related to artwork sales are the responsibility of the Artist.

Insurance/Liability: CANO cannot insure work/equipment, or be responsible for loss, theft or damage. Efforts are made to ensure that all work remains safe and undamaged, but an artist may wish to retain their own insurance. CANO reserves the right to use images of accepted work for promotional purposes. Submission of your entry indicates your acceptance of the rules of this show.
